

Hello Gwyneth,

I just had to tell you how much I appreciate your animal work and sharing it!

On Monday I listened to your tapping session with Karin, for Tiki. I tapped along and as often happens when I tap, I had my dog come and sit with me and also several of my 12 cats. They really pick up the energy!

I've been tapping with/for animals for just a few months and have seen some really incredible things. But I especially wanted to say Thank You for this session recording. Tapping 'talking about', 'talking to' and 'talking as' has been soooo helpful!

We have a 6 month old feral kitten that my mom found in her yard. My mom had been feeding the mother cat, who had 2 kittens under her back porch. The mom cat obviously favored one kitten over the other and at about 3 months old, she just quit feeding the little tiger. Ma found her in her yard, nearly dead. So underweight and cold.....too weak to run away or even lift her head, we thought Sophie would be dead in a couple of hours. (with tapping, there's a happy ending for the mom and other kitten, too)

We did all the right stuff, Sophie is with us, 2 months later. Still a bit undersized but basically doing well.

Now here's the amazing thing: Being feral, Sophie is pretty skittish, she's afraid to be handled and would let us touch her only one or two pettings before she'd turn on us, spitting and scratching. Slowly she's warming up but it's really slow going.

Monday I listened to Tiki and Karin and when my husband got home from work, I asked him if we could tap for Sophie. She's his cat, so he agreed (kind of a surprise, he's still a bit afraid of this weird stuff). Anyway, we did it as you did, he talked about Sophie, to Sophie and as Sophie. We were both awed when as Sophie he said she's afraid to let us get close to her heart, she loved her mom and her mom abandoned her and she's afraid we'd do the same thing if she let herself love us.

Is that cool or what? We never would have figured that out ourselves! We tapped for 20 minutes around some of Sophie's concerns, till she felt safe.

The next day we had friends stop by and Sophie was all over them, purring and affectionate. Strangers! She didn't run and hide! And she's so much better, calmer and relaxed, she actually smiles! And yesterday I had to check her teeth and while she got a bit upset, she let me.

Thank you so much from the bottom of my heart! I love tapping and would like to focus on working with cats. I live in the US, will you be offering recordings of your animal tapping seminars? (oops, maybe you do and I haven't seen them yet...)

If Sophie could say it, I'm sure she'd say thank you and send you a big purr, too.
